### Seniors Make your Mark!

#### Painted Parking Spots Cost:\$100

(does not include parking permit or supplies: paint, brushes, etc.)

*All proceeds to Grad Night and maintenance*



#### Rules:

- 1. Parking Painting will be done on scheduled Saturdays between 7:00 am to 12:00 pm.**
  - You must begin by 10 am. NO EXCEPTIONS! In case of inclement weather or other complications, a make--up date and future dates will depend on demand; we may have one paint day a month.
- 2. All designs must be approved by Mr. Latham and / or Mr. Peterson before painting.**
  - A copy of your design must be approved by Mr. Latham or Mr. Peterson.

  - Clearly draw the design and include the colors you will be using.

- Your parking spot design must include at least your graduation year.
- Think of your space as a shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Any design associated with gangs, advertising drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene slogan, handicap symbols or symbols that may cause confusion or promote illegal activities will not be allowed nor approved. You may include your name, jersey number, instrument you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans and anything unique to you that meets administrative approval. Make it fun!

### **3. Designs must be school appropriate.**

- No offensive language, pictures, flags or symbols.
  - No negative, offensive, or rude language.
  - No “gang-style” tagging.
  - No double meanings.
  - No nicknames, no girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. (ONLY your own name)
- Note: Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Principal, Assistant Principal, or School Resource Officer. Disciplinary action may be taken and you will forfeit your right to an assigned parking space. Students will not be allowed to alter their spots after the assigned painting day.

### **4. Students will be notified by administration if their design is not acceptable. You must follow this design exactly on painting day – NO changes allowed.**

5. **Paint Requirements: WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX (Acrylic)** paint is the only type of paint that can be used. Students will also need to leave an approximately four inch unpainted border between the white parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. Please use blue painters' tape to ensure this border is accomplished. All paint will be the responsibility of the student.

### **UNAPPROVED PAINTS:**

No OIL BASED PAINT

No Fluorescent paint

No Reflective paint

No paint sprayers

No spray paint

No Clearcoat

**What to Bring:** Be sure to bring your approved design/sketches with you on paint day. Also, you will be responsible for all paint brushes, rollers, paint pans and paint tape\*. A broom to sweep off your spot before painting will save you lots of time. You will want to bring a canopy, sunscreen, drinks, stencils, rags for cleaning, sacks or bags to dispose of trash, and a drop cloth and paint clothes. Also, consider bringing knee pads and clothing you don't mind getting dirty.

- Students are required to clean up their area (including, paint and brushes) when they are finished
- Please remember to bring sunscreen and water to drink and have fun. We will have waters and light breakfast snacks provided.

**Items to Remember:**

- Check in upon arrival with your approved design form.
  - Water based primer paint/base coat for concrete if desired
  - Chalk to sketch design
  - Paint brushes and/or paint rollers\*
  - Paint roller extension\*
  - Paint pans or plastic containers for water\*
  - Paint and brushes
  - Blue painters tape (4 inches wide)\*
  - Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
  - Broom and/or dust blower to sweep spot\*
  - Old cloths or paper towels
  - A bag for your trash
  - Sunshade, Sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats
  - Water, snacks
  - Lawn chairs, stool, towel to sit on
  - People to help you. Painting your space will take more time than you think
  - Simple, solid color and bold line designs show better and are easier to paint.
  - Think about where your tires will fit in the space. Tires will wear away your design.
